

WHEN CAN A SICK CHILD RETURN TO SCHOOL?



Yes

No one in the household is symptomatic, nor is awaiting COVID-19 test results, nor is a close contact to a case.

No

Student or household member is sick.

Sick and not COVID-19 tested.

Entire household must isolate for 10 days from symptom onset. If the student was sick, they can return after 10 days and 24 hours of being symptom-free.

Student or household member is a close contact to a case.

Sick and COVID-19 tested.

If results are negative, 1) a well student can return to school immediately OR 2) if the student is sick, they can return after 24 hours of being symptom-free.

Student or household member has travelled outside the province.

Entire household must self-isolate for 14 days. The close contact (only) will be asked to take a COVID-19 test 10 days after the last exposure to a case.

Positive COVID-19 test

Entire household must continue to self-isolate—public health staff will provide direction.

Traveller must self-isolate away from other household members for 14 days. If this is not possible, the entire household must self-isolate with the traveller.

Negative COVID-19 test

Close contact must continue to self-isolate for entire 14 days—household members can stop self-isolating.
