Passion projects: Passion Projects are opportunities for students to participate in a fun activity that they are passionate about. These include activities such,

Music: Students can choose an instrument to play and have fun with. We have guitars, drums, keyboard, ukulele, violin

Dance: Students can participate in a dance class where they can have fun and learn a choreographed dance.

Art: Students can choose to work on an art project for entire semester

Learning centre:

It is a time when students work on their academic works. If the students do not have homework to work on, a staff will provide the student with academic work eg. read a book, Math problems, science worksheets, a topic to write to improve writing skill.

Registration is required to participate in the Village program.

Every student who participates in the program and follows the criteria is eligible for a scholarship at the end of the year:

- attend program each day
- participate in passion projects
- Work on homework or educational activities in the learning centre
- must show an improvement in grades over the course of the year
