

## Using Google Classroom at home


1. Open up an internet browser (Google Chrome works best for this application)  
Note: If you are using an iPad or iPhone you can download the Google Classroom app or look for this image:



2. Type in: [classroom.google.com](https://classroom.google.com) (or click on the app)
3. Sign in using your school email address and student number (if you have misplaced this information, please contact your teacher or Strathcona School)

Password: student number (eight digits)
