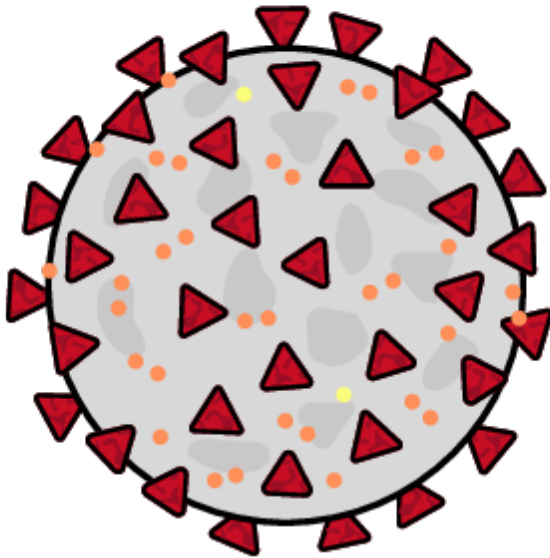
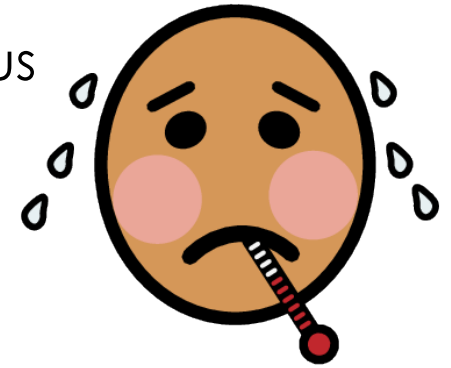


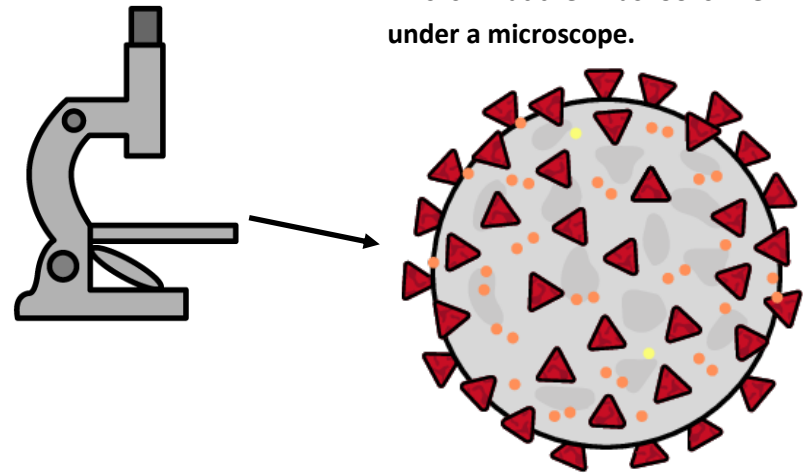
# COVID-19 (Coronavirus)

people sick.

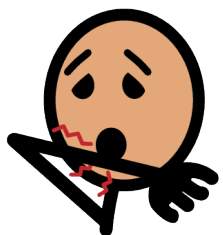


This is what the virus looks like

People who have the Coronavirus may have:



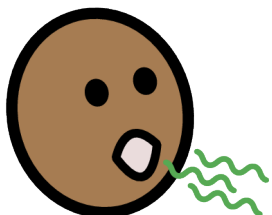
a sore throat, a dry cough,



a runny nose,

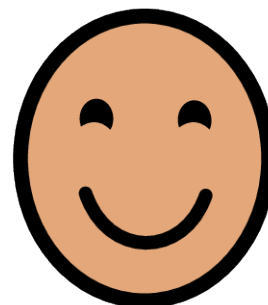


a fever,



and/or shortness of breath.

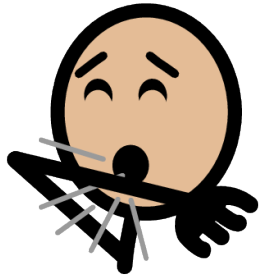
If you are sick stay home for at least 14 days.



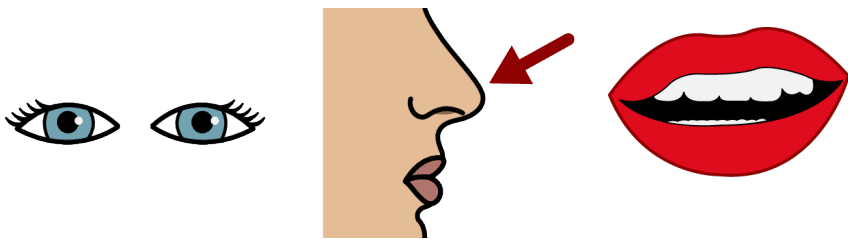
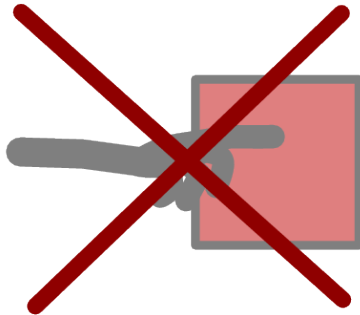
Most people who have the Coronavirus will feel better on their own.

Some people will have to go to the hospital to get better.



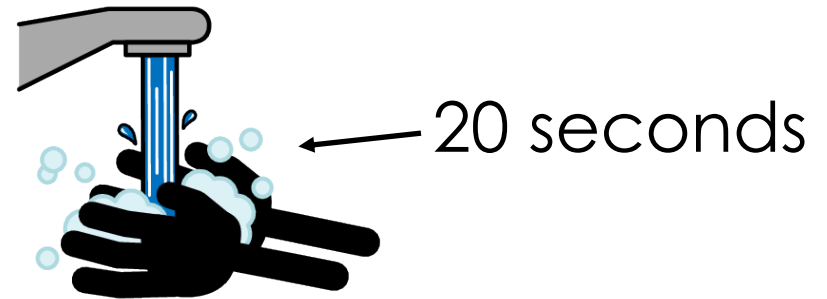


I need to sneeze into my elbow and not touch my eyes, nose and mouth.

I can help stop the spread of germs by washing my hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. I can sing "Happy Birthday" twice.

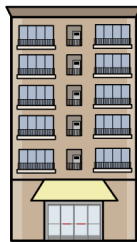
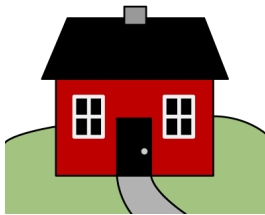


If I can't use soap, I can use hand sanitizer.





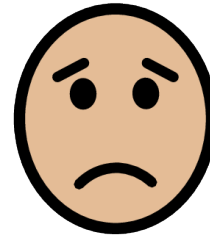
When schools are closed, I will stay at home. Schools will be closed from March 23 to at least April 13.



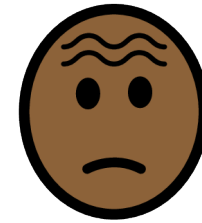
I will complete school-work while I am at home.

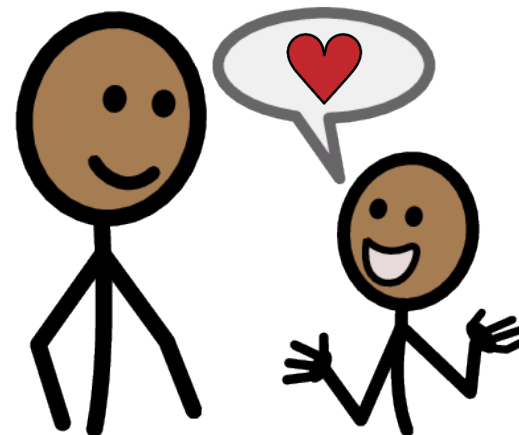
