*School SLPs work with students who have difficulty understanding language, using language, and/or making speech sounds.*

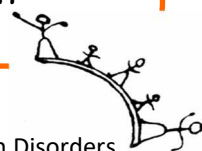
### LEAF PAINTING

- While walking in your neighborhood **talk** about the fall colours.
- **Talk** about what happens to the leaves in the fall (The leaves fall off the trees) – and the sounds that you hear (i.e., crunchy leaves, blowing wind...).
- Collect leaves of different shapes and sizes for a craft! **Use new words.**
- Arrange leaves on a piece of white paper. Use a small piece of tape on the back of each leaf. Stick the leaves onto the paper. Using red, yellow, orange, or brown paint—encourage your child to paint the leaves. Remove leaves when done. **Talk about what you are doing.**

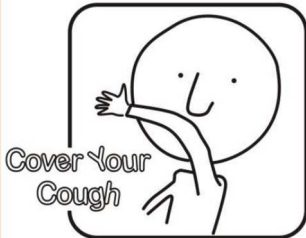


### Fun Fall Words!

No germs will be missed!

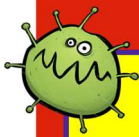
They may hide

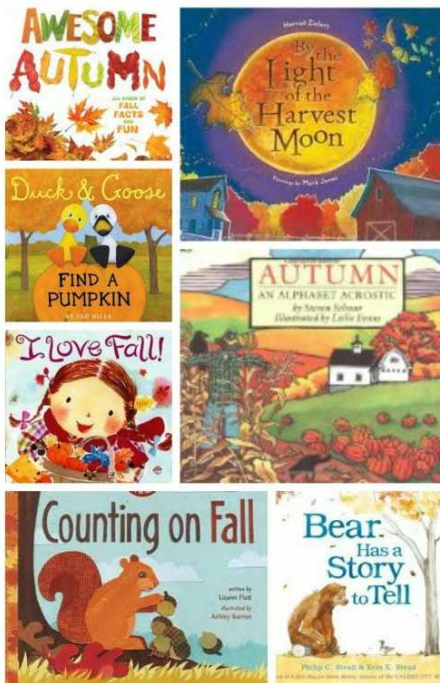
