May 4, 2018 (Winnipeg, MB) – Winnipeg School Division is pleased to invite media to the first ever WSD Youth for Sustainable Living conference being held on Wednesday, May 9, 2018 at the Canadian Museum for Human Rights, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

The three pillars of the conference are Expose (the problem); Empower (the masses); Educate (the people). Students from Grades 7 to 12 from across Winnipeg School Division attending the conference will hear from three keynote speakers on social justice, economic factors and the environment. Students will also attend three out of 18 workshops. In addition, an art installation will be developed throughout the day.
