Winnipeg School Division Celebration Pow Wow 2018

May 28, 2018 (Winnipeg, MB) – Winnipeg media are invited to join Winnipeg School Division (WSD) students, staff and community at Tec Voc High School field on Wednesday, May 30 for the 2018 WSD Celebration Pow Wow.

Festivities are open to the community and begin with the Grand Entry at 12:00 p.m., followed by drumming, dancing, and entertainment. At 4:30 p.m., an Honour Song will begin for Winnipeg School Division Graduates and Build From Within Students. A traditional feast will also begin at 4:30 and Closing Ceremonies will be held at 6:30 p.m.

Master of Ceremonies at the 2018 WSD Pow Wow is Ray "Coco" Stevenson, a well-known traditional singer and drummer who lives in Winnipeg. Host Drummers are the Walking Wolf Singers who perform traditional Indigenous dances, sharing with audiences the stories and meanings behind them. The group's performances include hoop dancers, jingle dancers, friendship dancers, drummers and chanters.

WSD was established in 1871 and currently has 78 schools, 33,000 students and 6,000 employees. Its purpose is to provide a learning environment that fosters the growth of each student's potential and provide equitable opportunity to develop the knowledge, skills and values necessary for meaningful participation in a global and diverse society.
