

**D: Bill 18 The Public Schools Act –
“Safe and Inclusive Schools”**

In this Act ‘bullying’ is behaviour that is intended to cause, or should be known to cause, fear, intimidation, humiliation, distress or other forms of harm to another person’s body, feelings, self-esteem, reputation or property; or is intended to create, or should be known to create, a negative school environment for another person.

Cyber bullying is bullying by means of any form of electronic communication, including social media, text or instant messaging, websites, or e-mail.

E: Drugs, Alcohol, Weapons:

Be aware that trafficking, using, possessing or being under the influence of alcohol or illicit drug is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.

Anyone who is found to possess and/or use a weapon or a facsimile of such a weapon that may be used for causing bodily harm will not be tolerated.

B: River Elm School Code of Rules:

Consequences for Unacceptable Behaviour:

Any unacceptable conduct where a student does not respond to adult intervention will result in but not limited to:

- Variety of intervention strategies within the classroom
- Parents/Guardians are notified
- Variety of intervention strategies within the school
- Incident report filled out
- Intervention Plan will be developed in consultation with appropriate staff services and parents/guardians
- In-school Suspension
- Winnipeg School Division Policy JGD – *Suspension of Students* is followed at River Elm School

C: Attendance and Punctuality

For students to learn to their best abilities, students must attend school every day and on time. Illnesses, medical appointments, and family emergencies are legitimate reasons for absences.

Please notify the school office when your child(ren) will be absent.

Did You Know Facts

- *If your child is 10 minutes late every day, they will have lost six days of instructions by the end of the school year.*
- *If your child misses only 2 days per month of school, they will have missed one month worth of instruction by the end of the school year.*
- *If your child misses 15 days of school every year, they will have lost one year of instruction by the end of grade 12.*
