English Language Arts

Students will be focused on the following skills throughout the year:

- Listening, speaking, reading, writing, viewing and representing

Strategies to be used to develop these skills:

- Spelling and grammar using weekly practice
- Reading and writing with Daily 5
- Creative Writing
- Literature Circles
- Exposure to a variety of texts and writing styles

Math

Math will be taught with a focus on various strategies and represent comprehension and solutions concretely, pictorially and symbolically. Students will learn about:

Science

Students will explore the following topics while learning problem solving, decision and inquiry skills.
