**Winnipeg School Division assigns temporary home schools for
Castlebury Meadows and Waterford Green residents**

April 19, 2018 (Winnipeg, MB) – In anticipation of a new school opening by September 2020 in the Northwest part of Winnipeg School Division (WSD), new registrations for the 2018/2019 school year for students currently living in the Castlebury Meadows and Waterford Green housing developments are as follows:

To register, parents/guardians must go to their home school in person. At the time of registration, parents are required to provide the following documents:

- Manitoba Medical card listing the child and parent(s) name or other medical card listing the child and parent(s) name from another province.
- A copy of your property tax bill or rental/ lease agreement or an accepted "offer to purchase" document with the possession date shown.
- Your child's birth certificate, baptismal certificate, certificate of live birth, statutory declaration, Canadian Passport or Treaty Card.
- Legal guardians are required to provide a Court of Queen's Bench document signed by a judge.
- Non-citizens are required to provide one of the following:
 - Landed Immigrant (permanent residence) documents
 - Work Visa
 - Study Visa
 - Refugee Status

Note: *if you have none of the above but have made application for permanent residency, you are considered a visitor and therefore must pay and have health medical coverage.*

Students from the two developments who registered in a school prior to today's announcement will be grandfathered and may continue at their current school or may opt to move to the above assigned home school for the next two years. Transportation is provided for Kindergarten to Grade 6 students living 1.6 kilometers or further from their assigned home school.

The new school being built is Dual Track French Kindergarten to Grade 8 and English Nursery to Grade 8 with a capacity upon opening in 2020 for 600 students. A child-care facility with a capacity of 74 spaces is also included in the building project.

WSD was established in 1871 and currently has 78 schools, 33,000 students and 6,000 employees. Its purpose is to provide a learning environment that fosters the growth of each student's potential and provide equitable opportunity to develop the knowledge, skills and values necessary for meaningful participation in a global and diverse society.
