What is Google Classroom?


Think of Google Classroom (GC) as your child's digital link to learning.

Teachers use GC to share assignments, homework, newsletters, and much more with students AND parents! During Home Learning is a means of communicating with students on a regular basis.

Getting Started


Your child has been provided with a **WSD login and password** that is unique to them.

- 1. Click on the Google Chrome Browser icon. If you do not have Chrome you can use a different Internet browser like Firefox, or Edge.
- 2. Type https://goo.gl/S0g7kR into your web address bar. You may want to bookmark this web address.




3. Sign in with your child's username and password.

4. You will now see that you are signed in to your Google Apps for Education account! Click on the 9 squares (Waffle/Rubik's Cube) icon in the top right hand corner to see the Google Suite of Products!




Navigating Classroom?
