Priorities for 2017-2018

- We will continue to focus on instructional and assessment practices to support student learning through the incorporation of technology and innovation.
- Student engagement and their social-emotional wellbeing is always at the forefront. We will continue to work on our school wide Wellness and Mindfulness Programming.
- Our Math Support Teacher will support staff and students in Flexible Thinking.
- Our school focus will be on writing in both French and English.
- Our Innovation Support Teachers will lead classes to integrate innovation and technology in both French and English.
- We will strive to ensure 90% of our students are reading at or beyond grade level and to reduce the number of students requiring an Individualized Education Plan by 15%.
- All students will work with the pillars of Education for Sustainable Development.
- We will continue to develop our new Resource Model to support all learners.
- Our Grade 5/6 Leadership program will provide leadership opportunities through working with younger students, assisting with special events, and contributing to our school.
- Our Clinical Support Services Team consists of a speech and language pathologist, psychologist, social worker, reading clinician and audiologist and will continue to support our students and staff. They will work with small groups, individual and whole classes and will provide professional development for teachers.

Innovation at École Garden Grove School

They were Regional Finalists in the Samsung Contest, represented Manitoba at an International Creativity Tournament called Destination Imagination and attended the WSD STEAM Centre. Next, we are hoping to go to space on the NASA project. We will continue to build these skills beginning in Nursery and will ensure that our students have all they need to succeed. We hope to see everyone out to our Family Innovation Night next year!
