

Planting your Bean Seeds

Watch me plant my bean seeds on SeeSaw if you need help!

Step 1: Put your dirt pod into a bowl with $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of water. (It will puff up 3 times the size in about 30 minutes).	Step 2: Place expanded dirt pod in your cardboard planter.
Step 3: Gently push your bean seeds down into the dirt pod about half an inch, or one paper clip length. Cover with soil.	Step 5: Place your plant pot in a dish (so the water does not leak out everywhere), in a sunny spot in your home.
Step 6: Now you wait!! It will take between 5-10 days for your beans to sprout, make sure it stays damp.	Step 7: When your beans sprout (come out of the dirt) continue to water them regularly.
Step 8: Use your Plant Journal to draw what your beans look like each day and measure how tall they get using the paper clip or other small object.	Step 9: If you can, transplant your beans to an outside garden when it is about a foot tall.
Step 10: Enjoy eating some delicious beans!
