Finding Equal


- Provide students, pairs, or small groups with a set of dominos.
- Have students find two dominoes that have the same sum or difference.
- Have students record both dominoes and write an equation that shows that they are equal. For example, a student might pull a 3 and 5 domino and a 4 and 4 domino. Their equation would be 3 + 5 = 4 + 4.
