

Students in grades 1-3 will complete the school year working on the manipulation skills of kicking and striking. There are three types of kicks we will work on. The place kick has us kicking the ball in a stationary position on the ground. The soccer kick is the most difficult kick, where we kick a moving ball and punting is where we will practice kicking a ball that is dropped from our hands and kicked before it touches the ground. While working on striking, we will play many lead up type baseball games such as Paddle Ball, Danish T-Ball and Racket Golf.



Students in grades 4-8 will complete the school year with a unit on track and field. We will develop an understanding of the rules and mechanics of the different events. We will develop skills in short and long distance running as well as jumping and throwing. All students will experience success and enjoyment through participation in the activities.

Room 4 and 12 had a great day outside to celebrate our year as reading buddies!




Warm weather means we'll be outside more so please send a hat and make sure students have footwear for running and playing!


**FOR THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR**

## **Emergency First Aid & CPR/AED level C courses provided by:**



Emergency First Aid & CPR/AED Level C Includes: Adult, child and infant CPR and choking management; AED certification and practice; prevention of disease transmissions; legalities; Red Cross emergency action principles/fundamental principles, treatment of deadly bleeding, shock treatment, secondary survey, heart attack, stroke, allergies, asthma, minor and major wound care (lacerations, abrasions, amputations, impalements, etc); administration of drugs protocol; and any relevant topics applicable to your needs as time allows.

**\*All participants will receive a CPR barrier device to ensure hygienic environment as well as their own mannequin to practice with. A variety of First Aid equipment/simulation kits will provide realistic training on all the First Aid practice.**


