We've been busy retelling familiar stories as one of the ways to read. Using the story of the Three Little Pigs as our starting point, we explored and collected different materials for building structures, learned about 3-dimensional shapes and created structures with straw, sticks and rocks (bricks). Our learning journey lead us to the idea of creating our own class movie which meant we needed to create storyboards, assign roles, write lines, practice, create sets and film video and sound bites.
