Course Outline

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OVERVIEW

Learning Spanish, like learning any other language, is an active and ongoing process. It requires patience, hard work and dedication on behalf of the student and the teacher.

Grade 7 Spanish is an introductory language course where students learn the basic structures of the language in terms of grammar, sentence structure, verbs and vocabulary. This will be achieved through speaking, listening, writing and reading. Students will be exposed to different modes in which the language is used with texts, music, games and videos.

Activities will be structured in a way that students of different abilities and levels in the language will be able to challenge themselves in whatever they do.

ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed based on their understanding of the essential learning outcomes:

- Applications (Use Spanish in a variety of situations and for a variety of purposes) **30%**
- Language Competence (Use Spanish effectively and competently) **40%**
- Global Citizenship (Exploration of the cultures of the Spanish-speaking world) **10%**
- Strategies (Know and use various strategies of learning and communication) **20%**

The final assessment is worth 20% of the final grade.
