OVERVIEW

Learning Spanish, like learning any other language, is an active and ongoing process. It requires patience, hard work and dedication on behalf of the student and the teacher.

Grade 8 Spanish builds upon the vocabulary and foundations set in Grade 7. Students will continue to work on grammar, sentence structure and verbs during thematic units throughout the year. Activities will be structured in a way that students of different abilities and levels in the language will be able to participate and challenge themselves.

ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed based on their understanding of the essential learning outcomes:

- Applications (Use Spanish in a variety of situations and for a variety of purposes) 30%
- Language Competence (Use Spanish effectively and competently) 40%
- Global Citizenship (Exploration of the cultures of the Spanish-speaking world) 10%
- Strategies (Know and use various strategies of learning and communication) 20%

The final assessment is worth 20% of the final grade.
