emotional development, and these benefits matter even more as young people are increasingly ensconced in the virtual world and as their anxiety levels continue to rise."

I know I can feel conflicted, thinking that students need to be in their classrooms at their desks for real learning to happen. Haidt, though, cites numerous research articles showing that recess promotes not only physical health and social development but also cognitive performance. His book is a great read, and I highly recommend it. So, if you hear your children talking about time they spent outside at school, know that they are engaging in thoughtful and meaningful activities that are developing their bodies and minds!
