The PAC Annual General Meeting will be held right after the welcome BBQ on September 2nd. This meeting includes election of the new Executive. Everyone is welcome to attend.

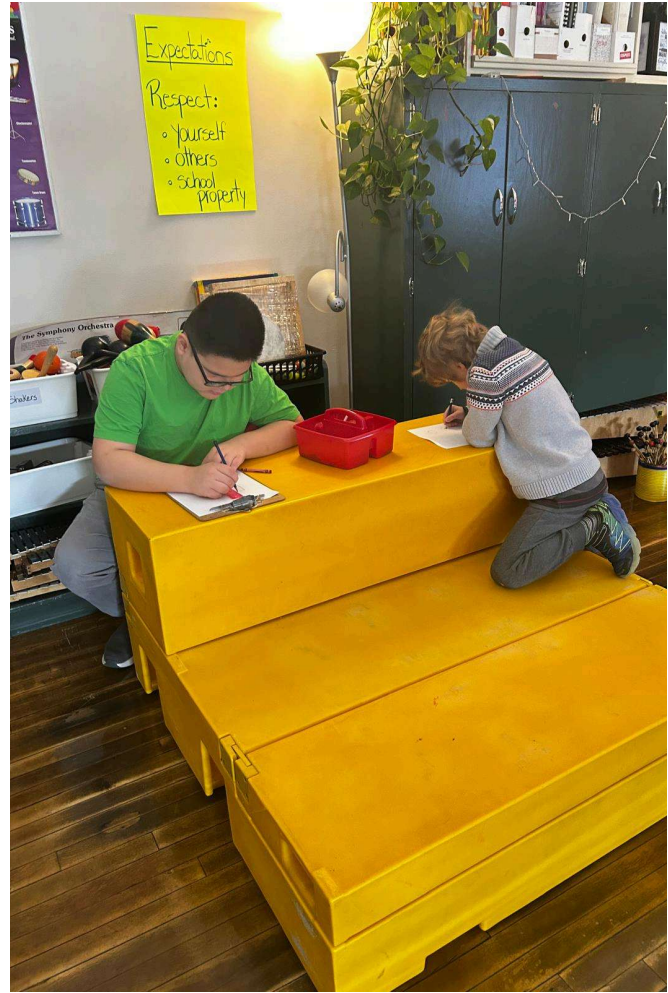


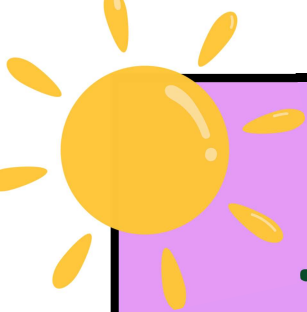
