We have started learning about the importance of the Land Acknowledgement as well as the Indigenous Seven Teachings. The focus for this Month is "Courage" represented by "Bear". I encourage you to have this conversation with your children and share your thoughts in what you think "Courage" means to you. Ms. Garand is the Indigenous Success Plan Leader in our school and she will be reaching out to the community to share the activities we do at the school and to ask for your input. We invite the community to participate with us as we move forward on the path of reconciliation.

We are also excited to have the Young Designer's Program in our school this month to work with our teachers in looking at how we can use S.T.E.A.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) in our classrooms. The students will be engaged in hands-on activities that will target multidisciplinary outcomes.

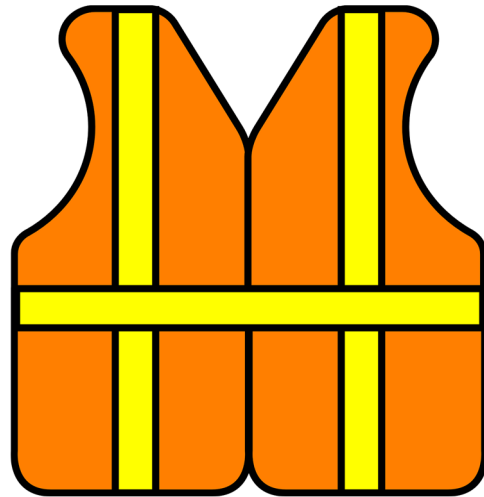

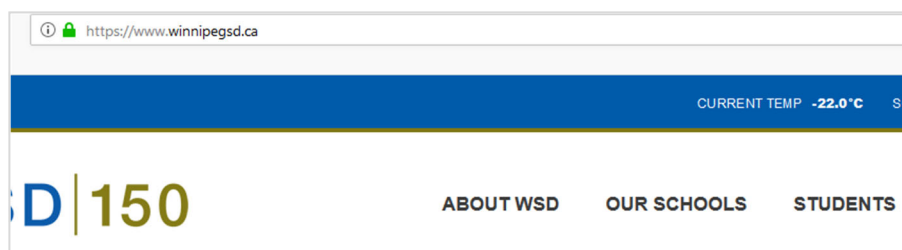
Dear Parents and Guardians of School Patrols:

With the colder weather coming soon, now is a good time to remind everyone of the school's cold weather guidelines.



When the temperature or windchill is -35 degrees Celsius or colder, there will be no patrols at their street corner street posts.

The Winnipeg School Division uses the **Environment Canada temperature reading at The Forks as a guideline**. Weather information is updated hourly and can be found on the Environment Canada Information line at 983-2050 or www.weatheroffice.gc.ca
Or go to the WSD Website and click on the temperature to see with the wind chill.



Please ensure that patrols are dressed in layers of warm clothing with an outer layer that is wind-resistant. Make sure to cover exposed skin by wearing a hat, mittens or insulated gloves, a scarf, neck tube or face mask, and have insulated, waterproof footwear.

Indigenous Academic Success

“The student, staff, and communities of Winnipeg School Division are committed to truth and reconciliation through building relations with Mother Earth, the original peoples of this land, and the stories that bring us together. We acknowledge the place in which we gather is on Treaty 1 territory, the homeland of the Red River Metis, and the ancestral lands of the Anishinaabe, Ininiwak, and Dakota Oyate peoples.”



Glenelm school has been undertaking some important work towards our competency in Indigenous ways of knowing. In previous years we explored the history of Manitoba and the role of the fur trade and Metis peoples in creation of our province. This culminated in a whole school field trip to the Festival du Voyageur.

Wâhkôhtowin is Cree for **all our relations**, this is a fundamental concept in understanding Indigenous culture and traditional beliefs because it highlights the importance of community. Glenelm school will be pursuing a deeper understanding of Wâhkôhtowin by having each student make a commitment to action based on the land acknowledgment and participate in land-based experiential learning!

The Indigenous success team will be planning a whole school Land-based learning day where everyone can gain new skills, appreciate the gifts from the land and animals and apply Indigenous knowledge.
