Hello Greenway Families,

We have gotten off to a great start this year, hopefully you have connected with your child(ren)'s teacher either on SeeSaw or through their Google Classroom.

We recently completed our Positive Behaviour Intervention Strategies common area training. This is where expectations for our behaviour are reviewed within specific areas of the school (i.e. recess, exit/entrances, hallways, etc...). An area that we are looking at focusing on is our problem-solving skills at recess. When we have a problem we are looking for our students to...

- STAY CALM and KEEP our hands and feet to OURSELVES.
- If we are ANGRY...find staff immediately, call for help or go into the school.
- If we are able...try and use our words in a calm and kind manner.
- Actively listen to one another and be willing to solve the problem
- Ask for HELP from staff if we can not agree

Much like learning to read, complete an inquiry project or play a musical instrument...solving a recess problem in a peaceful manner will take time and practice, there will be success and mistakes made. We are all here to support our students in this learning. If you have any questions or concerns please be sure to first contact your child's teacher and then if necessary we are happy to assist you.

Let's all be safe, be respectful and be learners TOGETHER!
