We would like to wish you all a very happy fall season. Be sure to enjoy the time together that this month offers, and we look forward to building on the successful start of the school year that we have had so far!

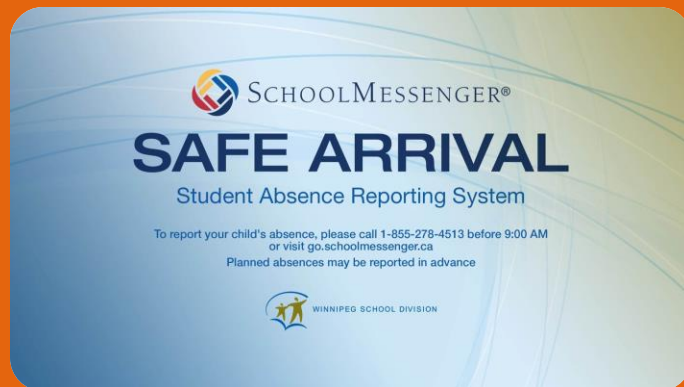
ABSENCE REPORTING

– Safe Arrival

The Winnipeg School Division uses an automated absence reporting system called Safe Arrival. The app can be downloaded onto your phone or computer to report an absence.

If you know that your child will be away, please report the absence either through the Safe Arrival app or by calling the school directly at 204-775-2455.

Please note that if a student is absent and the school has *not* been notified, Safe Arrival will call out to verify the absence.
