
Our students participated in learning on the Indigenous Peoples Atlas of Canada. This is a giant floor map that took up the entire half of the gym. In continuing our whole school learning on treaties, students were able to look and walk on a map that does not contain provincial boundaries, names of provinces, or many of the current names of cities and towns. Instead, it outlines the different Indigenous communities found across the country, the languages spoken, and the treaties signed with the Crown.

We have an exciting collaborative project taking place in P.E. classes with Ms. Thompson and Artist in the Schools. Sarah Teakle is a Circus Artist and is working with Ms. Thompson and our students in learning a variety of fun, active and challenging new skills, such as juggling, feather balancing, plate spinning, flower sticks, etc... We are looking forward to the student performance at the end of this exciting learning in May.
