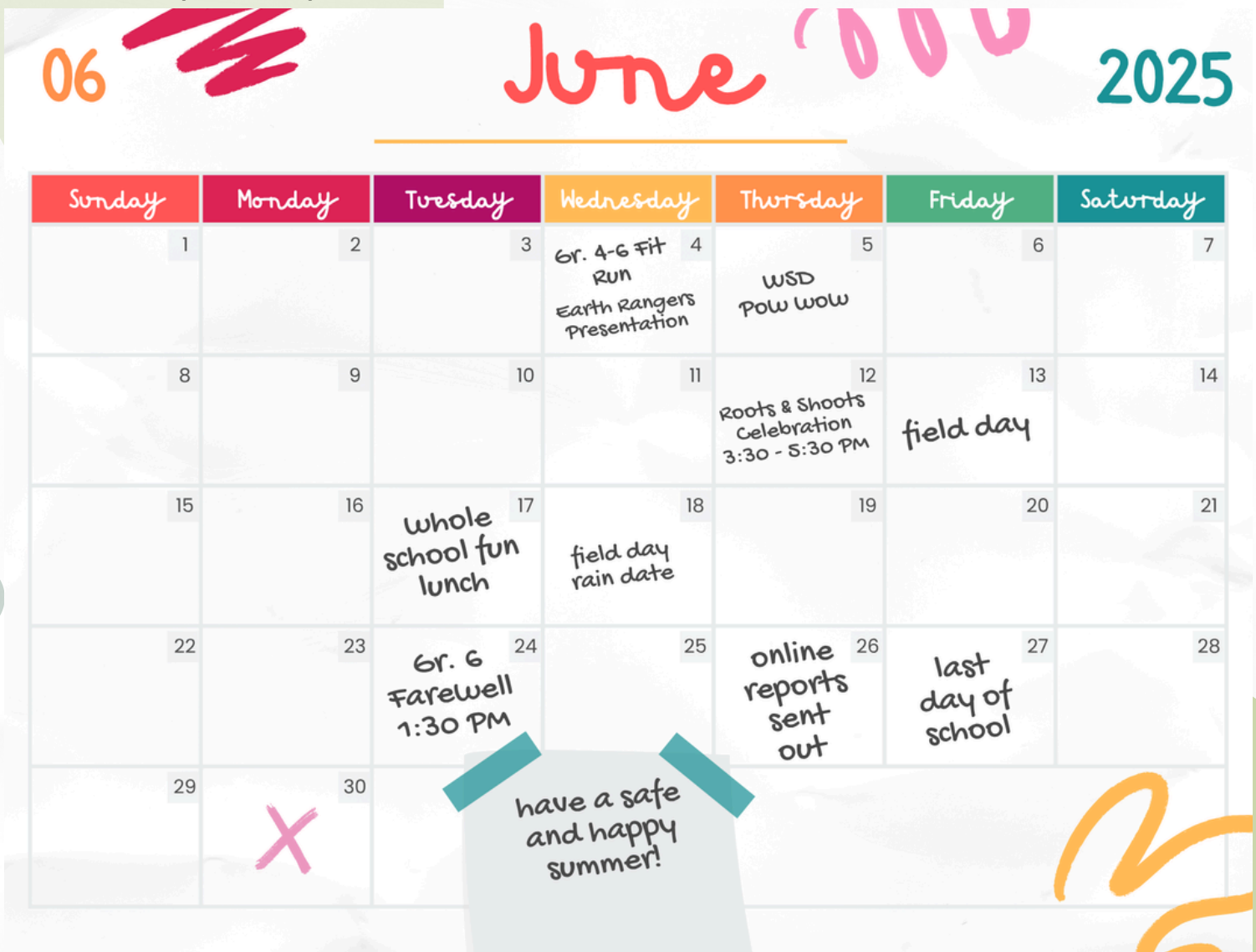
A Message from Rooms 203 and 206

Wildlife Haven is a rehabilitation centre that helps sick, injured or abandoned wildlife animals. They have been doing it since 1984. Wildlife Haven has also taken care of 55,000 wildlife patients, over 170 species of wildlife including mammals, song birds, reptiles, raptors and waterfowl.
