Dear Harrow School Families/Friends,

Welcome Back! And a huge warm Harrow welcome to our new students and their families/friends. We hope you have had a great, well-rested summer. We are excited about the new school year and we look forward to meeting our students as well as their families/friends. We are having a Meet the Staff evening on Thursday, September 14 from 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm. This is a great opportunity to come out and meet the staff and see your child's classroom. The new school year brings great opportunities for collaboration, dialogue and learning together as a community.

Our staff are ready and geared up for the learning opportunities they have in store for all the students. Learning is the focus of what we do and we will continue to look for ways to improve the way learning is delivered, executed and assessed.

We have new staff joining our school. We welcome to Harrow, Mr. Opena (Performing Arts Teacher) and Mrs. Gordon (Physical Education Teacher). They come with lots of experience in their respective fields and are eager to meet all of the students. Mme. Chernetz will be teaching .50% (morning N/K until December). The rest of the staff will remain intact and as changes are made, we will keep you posted.

Our school goals this year will continue to be strengthening skills, and continue to develop more strategies and assessment techniques in the areas of Literacy and Numeracy. All of our students will be assessed in reading, writing and numeracy skills during the first month and all programs will be adapted to meet their individual needs. Assessment happens on a daily basis! Another goal of ours is strengthening wellness strategies for all students. We will be focusing on PBIS (Positive Behavioural Interventions & Supports). This model helps our school be safe, caring and equitable, where every student feels valued, connected to the school community and supported by caring adults. We encourage all our families to support our Home Reading Program. Approximately 20 to 30 minutes of daily reading goes a long way toward developing successful readers and a passion for reading. We will monitor the reading at the school on a daily basis. We will continue to provide incentives for all students who are keeping up with their reading. If you require some suggestions as to how to support the Home Reading Program, please do not hesitate and contact your child's classroom teacher. We are here to support you on the journey to developing a love for reading with your child.

Our school newsletter is published monthly and is distributed through School Messenger. If you require a hardcopy, please let us know. The newsletter will also be posted on our website at: <https://www.winnipegssd.ca/schools/harrow>.

School has begun! The students in N/K (am and pm) - Room 2, Grade 1 students - Room 4 and Grade ½ students - Room 1 will line up at the Taylor & Harrow doors. Students in Grade 2/3 - Room 9, Grade 3/4 - Room 8, Grade 4/5 - Room 12 and Grade 5/6 - Room 10 will line up at the Ebby & Harrow doors (back of the school). Nursery/Kindergarten students (am & pm) will come to school on Wednesday and Thursday (staggered entry). They will start their full am or pm on Monday, September 11. Please check with the classroom teachers for more information or contact the school.

School supplies fees for N/K students is \$20.00 per child. For students in grades 1 to 6 the fee is \$40.00 per student. These fees will cover the cost of supplies for the school year. Classroom teachers will purchase items such as pencils, pencil crayons, erasers, notebooks, binders, etc. Please see the link sent out for payment. Please label indoor shoes. It is important that students have a reusable water bottle. We have two water filling stations at the school for students to fill their water bottles.

Our Parent Council Advisory will be meeting every first Tuesday of the month at the school in the library. The time for the meetings will be at 6:15 pm. Child care will be provided for those who need it. However, the first PAC meeting will be on Tuesday, September 12. Please plan on attending. At this meeting, we will vote in the PAC Executive for the coming school year.

The Lunch Program is up and running. Ms. Angela has her team ready to go and she is always looking for more help. If you can commit to 1 hour a day (paid time) - 12:00 to 1:00 pm, please contact the school and we will be happy to pass on the information to her. Fees for Lunch Program are paid monthly. These fees pay for supplies (microwaves, plastic cutlery, napkins, etc.), milk (white or chocolate) and lunch supervision (staffed). If you have any questions, you may contact her or you can call the school and ask to speak with Mr. Batista.
