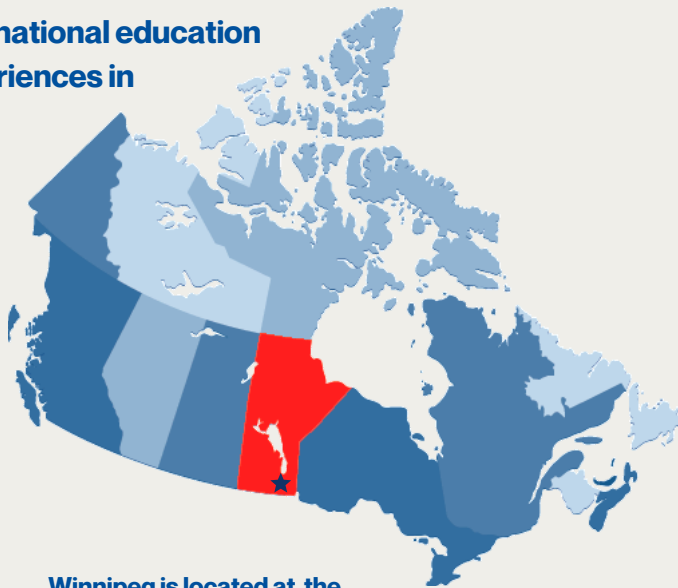

Students are taught Manitoba Provincial curriculum by government-certified teachers and English language development specialists. ## Apply Now

International students may join anytime, and for as few as four months, but students who take courses towards graduation must start at the beginning of a semester.

The Canadian school year operates from September to June.

High schools have two semesters:

- September to January
- February to June

Elementary and middle years students may begin in January.
