Homestay Family Application

Applying to be a Homestay Family for WSD International Education Program in four steps:

1. Homestay Family Application:

- a. Download and save the application form to a location on your computer
- b. Once saved, read and digitally complete the *Homestay Family Application*
- c. Save the form as "YourLastName Homestay Family Application"
- d. Send the completed application along with a photo of your family and a photo of the exterior of your home to homestays@wsd1.org

2. Checks: Submit clear checks, less than one year old, which must be renewed every three (3) years, subsequently, for every adult over the age of 18 living in your family home, including:

- a. Winnipeg Police Service Police Record Check/Police Vulnerable Sector Check. See: <https://policeinformationcheck.winnipeg.ca>
- b. Child Abuse Registry Check. See: https://www.gov.mb.ca/fs/childfam/child_abuse_registry.html

In addition, the room must contain a bed, linens and towels, desk, chair and lamp, a dresser and a clothes closet. International students must have a private bedroom of their own. All bedrooms must have a window to allow for fire/emergency exit. Windows cannot be obstructed, either inside or outside, in any way. It must be easy to exit the window if that is ever necessary. They cannot share a room with anyone.
