
Ms. Waldman - Arts Grades 1-7 (Cree/Ojibwe Classes)

Hi, My name is Ms. E. Waldman. I am the new Arts teacher for the language program. I am so excited to introduce (for some) and continue (for others) arts education for your children in the coming months! We will be learning key concepts related to visual art, dramatic/performing art, dance and music!

During the month of November in Visual Art we studied the element of line and how such a basic element can play such a big role in visual art! In December we will be moving on to the next element of art which will be shape. The students will learn about the difference in types of shapes like geometric and organic shapes and then make a 2D class project using shapes of their choice.

For Dramatic Arts we have just started to learn about character development and will be making up stories (for grades 1-3 classes) and scripts (for grades 4-7 classes) that the students will later perform for their classes. In Music/Dance we will begin to learn about rhythm and how to keep a beat, then we will play a game where we have to move to the beat.
