## **Message from Administration**

Celebrating students learning unites students, families, and schools, reinforcing achievements, inspiring growth, and strengthening support systems for continued educational success and community connection. This year families are invited into our November Student Led Conferences on evening of November 21st from 4:00 - 8:00 and Friday November 22nd from 1:00-3:30.

The model of student-led conferences aligns well with the values of our school community in several They emphasize holistic learning, relationship-building, and community engagement. Student-led conferences are important and impactful because they actively involve students in their own learning journey, making them a central part of the conversation about their progress and goals. Student Led Conferences help strengthen relationships between students, families, and schools by supporting:

A Learner-Centered Approach - Learning is deeply personal and self-directed. Students are encouraged to take responsibility for their own learning, which is reflected in the student-led conference model. In these conferences, students take charge of discussing their progress, goals, and areas of improvement, fostering a sense of agency and accountability that is central to all our family's core beliefs

Community and Relational Learning - Learning is not just for individual growth but for the well-being of the collective. Student-led conferences invite family and community members into the conversation, creating an opportunity for collaborative reflection on the student's learning journey. This reflects the relational aspect of education, where family and community are integral to the learning process.

Oral Tradition and Storytelling - Oral tradition and storytelling are fundamental aspects of Indigenous peoples' identities. Student-led conferences allow students to narrate their own learning journey, reflecting on their experiences, challenges, and growth. This process of sharing through narrative aligns with the storytelling traditions of Indigenous cultures, where knowledge is passed on through spoken word, personal stories, and reflective dialogue.

Holistic Development - Student-led conferences often encourage students to reflect on more than just academic achievements, addressing personal growth, emotional well-being, and future aspirations.

Respect for Diverse Learning Styles - Student-led conferences give students the opportunity to showcase their learning in ways that best suit their individual strengths and learning styles, whether through portfolios, presentations, or other means. This respect for multiple forms of expression and understanding is consistent with values found within our community.

Reciprocity and Shared Responsibility - Learning is often seen as reciprocal—students learn from others and contribute to the learning of the community. The model of student-led conferences supports this by creating a space where the student's voice is central, but also where the input of teachers and family members is valued, fostering a shared responsibility for the student's growth.

Overall, student-led conferences build a more engaged, supportive network around the student, which can improve academic performance, personal growth, and the relationship between students, families, and schools. Student-led conferences reinforce the idea that education is a collaborative effort. Families gain a clearer insight into how they can support their child at home, aligning their efforts with the school's objectives and creating a supportive environment for the student.

#### ABSENCE REPORTING SYSTEM

School Messenger allows parents/guardians to report student absences, late arrivals, early departures and vacations by phone, web or smartphone app. Parents/ guardians will report all absences through School Messenger before 9:00 AM and will not receive a phone call from the school.

For safety reasons, in the event of an unexplained student absence, the system will communicate with parents in a timely manner.

#### Phone:
