

Online Registration opens at 9:00AM





DID YOU KNOW...

- . More than 80% of learning relies on vision
- One in three children entering school has a problem with their vision
- Reading, learning and behaviour problems can be related to undetected vision disorders

Signs that may indicate a child has a vision problem include:

- Frequent eye rubbing or blinking
- · Short attention span
- · Avoiding reading and other close activities
- · Frequent headaches
- Covering one eye
- Tilting the head to one side
- · Holding reading materials close to the face
- · An eye turning in or out
- Seeing double
- Losing place when reading

Eye exams are covered by Manitoba Health for children under 19 years of age.

Winnipeg School Division is now offering comprehensive eye exams at your child's school, in partnership with Mobile Vision Care Clinic.
