*The Lunch Program is a non-profit program run by following the advice and guidelines discussed and agreed to by the parents of registered children, the Lansdowne Parent Council, the Lunch Program Coordinator and school administration. It provides a safe and nurturing environment during the lunch hour.*

- The lunch program is available for students in Grades 1-8 at École Lansdowne. Direct supervision is from 11:15 am to 12:15 pm. Half of this time is spent outside, weather permitting.
- All students (fulltime or casual) staying at school for lunch are required to fill out and return a registration form. Registrations are due no later than **Monday, June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2024**.
- Please advise Mary Sutton and the office if your child will be leaving the school at lunch.
- Students are required to follow all lunch hour responsibilities; listen and follow the directions of the coordinator and supervisors, inside and outside the school and respect fellow students, their belongings and personal space.
- We ask that you **do not drop off fast food or lunches every day**. Please provide your child with a healthy lunch each morning.
- Please do not send items with any peanuts or tree nuts.
- Microwaves for heat up are not available.
- **Fees that are not paid on or by the dates listed on the registration form will be subject to a \$5.00 late fee per child.** If no arrangements are made to pay, parents will be contacted to pick up their child and registration will be cancelled. Re-registration fees are \$5.00 per child and all outstanding fees must be paid prior to reinstatement in the Lunch Program.
