MESSAGE FROM ADMINISTRATION:

November is a month for reflection. As Remembrance Day approaches, it's important that we take the time to think about the rights, freedoms, and privileges we enjoy as Canadians. We will be having a Remembrance Day service on Friday, November 10th at 10:30 am in our gymnasium. Poppies will be distributed to students and donations will be accepted in the office the week prior to Remembrance Day. We encourage those in attendance to wear red or black. Brownies, Girl Guides, Cubs, Beavers, Scouts, and Cadets are invited to wear their uniforms that day.

École Lansdowne teachers have been busy observing, assessing and evaluating students over the past two months and are now ready to share information with you about your child's progress so far this school year. Provincial report cards for Nursery to grade 8 will be sent home on Tuesday, November 14th. In-person tri-conferences are coming up on November 16th and 17th! We ask that you read over your child's report card before your meeting in order to benefit the most from your appointment. We ask that you make every effort to attend the conferences with your child so that we may have the opportunity to all work together to build a successful partnership in your child's learning.

The annual Terry Fox run took place on September 26th-28th, 2023. As a school, we were able to raise \$204 dollars for the Terry Fox Foundation to help support Cancer Research.

We want to once again thank all of our families who participated in this year's chocolate fundraiser - your efforts and support are greatly appreciated! We cannot thank you enough for your generosity! Our Leadership students will be running a Koats 4 Kids drive until November 30th. Should you have any gently used or new winter clothing that you are willing to donate, please drop it off at the office.

Now that winter is upon us, we want to remind parents to always send your child(ren) to school dressed appropriately for the colder weather. Students will be sent outside three times a day for recess unless weather conditions are extreme. All students need to have a warm jacket, hat, mitts, and boots in the fall, and once we start getting a lot of snow we recommend a scarf and ski pants to stay warm while outdoors.

- Students line up outside, teachers greet students and walk them to their classrooms

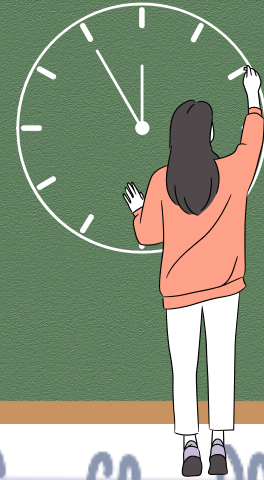
8:25 am: O Canada and Announcements

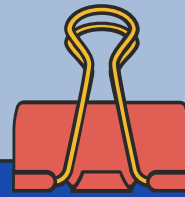
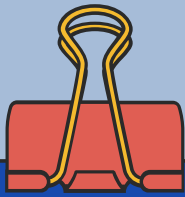

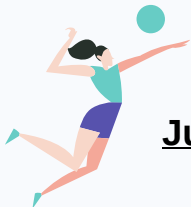
