Dear Niji Mahkwa Families,

December began with a fantastic Winter Concert that showcased the talents of our students and staff. Santa came for a visit on Dec. 18th and gave each student a gift! Staff and students came together to enjoy a pancake breakfast. December truly was an amazing month filled with learning, laughter and kindness.

Unlike the January 1 New Year based on the Gregorian calendar, traditional Indigenous New Year observances coincide closer to the "natural" cycles of Mother Earth. Some Indigenous people have been observing the blessings of a new year for a few weeks now since the winter solstice, also known as the first day winter, which occurred on December 21. The winter solstice provides a time to celebrate the good things to come. December 21 is the day with shortest amount of sunlight so the winter solstice represents the return of the sun. Along with it, the sun brings longer days and the foods provided by Mother Earth.

While there is much joy and celebration in this time of renewal. Indigenous people pass down their knowledge through oral tradition. Yet, it is up to the next generation to absorb the words of their Elders and preserve traditional knowledge. As educators of the younger generation it is our responsibility to carry on Indigenous traditions of smudging, sharing circles, feasts and pipe ceremonies, so they will not continue to diminish. In this sense, the New Year gives us an opportunity to see how far we've come and how far we still have to go.

Once again the frigid temperatures of January and snow are upon us but rest assured that we will be keeping warm and busy inside Niji Mahkwa.
