In our Indigenous Languages, Bear Feast in Cree is Maskwa Makosewin and in Ojibwe, its Mahkwa Wiigongewin. In March the bear is in the process of waking from her long winter sleep. She has been fasting for us all winter and is hungry. The Mahkwa Feast acknowledges that we are ready to listen to hear what she has to say and we appreciate her for the work she did for us during the long winter. The students who come to our school fully participate in acquiring the basic understandings, protocols and fundamental underpinnings of our ancestor's way of life. The goal is to assist our students and parents/guardians to embrace the idea that these practices serve good purposes in a student's life, in the modern world.
