Welcome back to school! We just wanted to send out a reminder to all families regarding what the day at Niji Mahkwa looks like. We are dedicated to upkeeping the safety and health of our students. If you have any questions please call the school.

- MORNING:** Students should arrive no earlier than 8:50 a.m.
Students will wait outside until their teacher meets them at 8:55 a.m.
Students are not allowed in the school prior to 8:55 a.m.
Students are to enter at different entrances depending on classroom. Please see the chart below for where your student will line up. If your child is late please drop them off at the front doors.
- AFTERNOON:** Students who go home for lunch are to come back no earlier than 12:50 and line up by their doors.
Students who stay for lunch will eat inside for the first half hour and go outside for the second half hour.
Lunch fees are due at the beginning of each month, payable to the classroom teacher or office. Lunch fees are \$20.00 (+10.00 for each additional child) per month.
