






#### **Classroom News from Room 217**

Our classroom is buzzing with energy and enthusiasm as students delve into various engaging learning tasks. Here's a glimpse of what's happening in our classroom. We have started "Thinking Classrooms". Thinking classroom is an instructional approach that focuses on fostering a positive and interactive learning environment, encouraging students to develop critical thinking skills and a growth mindset. The emphasis is on making students active participants in their own learning. Students work collaboratively on vertical surfaces, promoting a more interactive learning experience. It promotes communication and collaboration among students. Ask your child to share their learning with the "Thinking Classroom" tasks at home.







In mathematics, our focus this month is on shapes and solids. Students are exploring the characteristics of various shapes, both two-dimensional and three-dimensional. We are becoming shape detectives, identifying and classifying two-dimensional shapes such as circles, squares, triangles, rectangles, and more. We're incorporating activities that allow students to visualize and manipulate shapes and foster a deeper understanding of geometry concepts.







#### **Room 203**
