Welcome to the Family Room!

Our Family room is a welcoming space where we have our monthly Parent Council meetings and programming throughout the year. We have a free clothing depot and sewing machines. I can help with any resources you need. You can call, email, or speak to me live.

**Weekly food security** for potatoes, onions, and bread. The program will start later in the month. They are looking for a depot to work from as the former depot no longer has space.

**Meals 2go** - every student will take home a m2go bag every Friday. N/K a.m. students will be given to them on Monday mornings as meals to go are dropped off at our school in the late afternoons. Bags are filled with food items such as fruit, yogurt, cheese strings and milk. This program will start in the next couple of weeks.

Parent Council Meetings – These meetings are a great way to share school information and meet other Parent/Guardians. We offer free childcare and a light dinner. Our first Parent Council Meeting is on Wednesday, September 24th at 5:00 p.m. Please let me know if you are attending to make sure we have enough food. I have some ideas for programming such as pottery and learning indigenous languages. I want to hear from you. If you have any suggestions of something you would like to learn or learn more about, please let me know. Our beading/sewing was fun last school year. Our Parents/Guardians met new people, learned to make dreamcatchers, earrings and had good snacks.


