HOME READING

Reading is a huge emphasis to your child's learning journey. Your child should be able to read 20 words per minute by midyear and 40 words by the year's end.

In order to achieve this, we need your help. Read with your child and help them with their sounds, using their tracking fingers, and learning basic sight words.

Here are some questions you can ask your child before, during, and after reading with them.

Before: Can you look at the pictures and predict what will happen in this book? What does the cover tell you about the book?

During: What is the problem in the book? Why did you think the character did that? Can you put what you've read in your own words?

After: Why do you think the author wrote this book? What was your favourite part of the story? Did you like the book? Why or why not? ASSESSMENT

Assessment in Room 208 will be on-going. I will program for each child based on observations and student conferencing.
