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Home Reading

Students are expected to be reading at home for 20+ minutes, daily. Home reading books will be sent home soon.

Comprehension is a goal for all of the students in Room 209. Here are some questions you can ask your child before, during, and after reading with them.

Before:

- *Can you look at the pictures and predict what will happen in this book?
- *What does the cover tell you about the book?

During:

- *What is the problem in the book?
- *Why do you think the character did that?
- *Can you put what you've read in your own words?

After:

- *Why do you think the author wrote this book?
- *What was your favourite part of the story?
- *Did you like the book? Why or why not?



Assessment

Assessment in Room 209 will be on-going. I will program for each child based on observations and student conferencing.

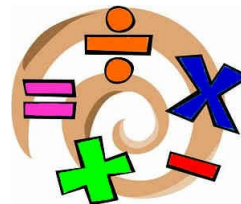
Language Arts
