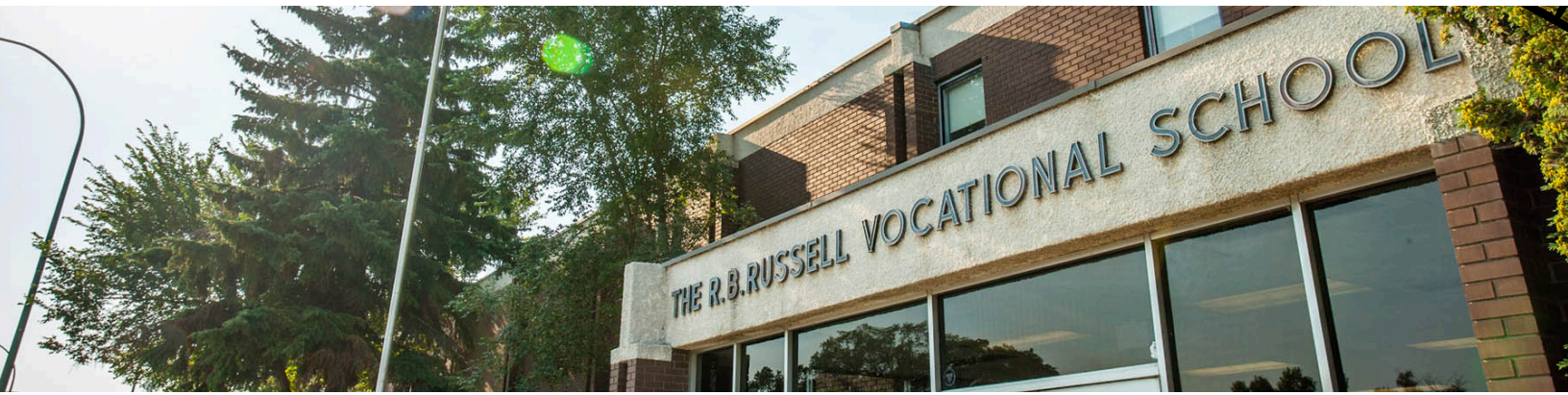

- No Fever
(without fever-reducing medicine for 24 hours)

- No Vomiting or Diarrhea
(for 48 hours)

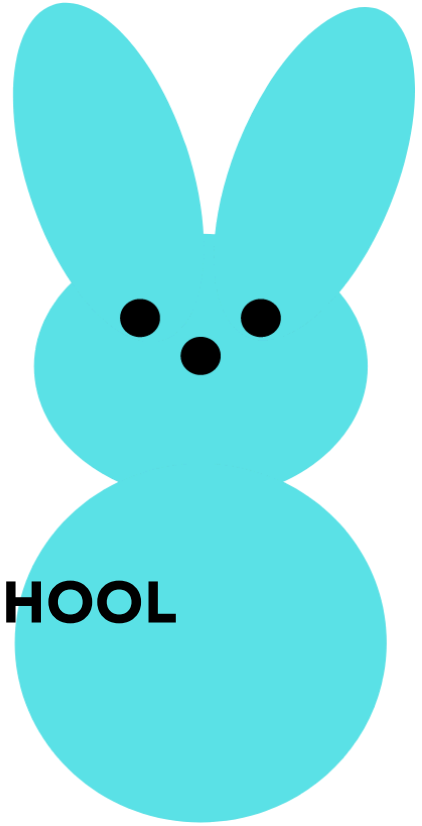

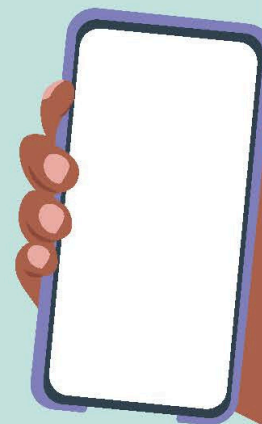
