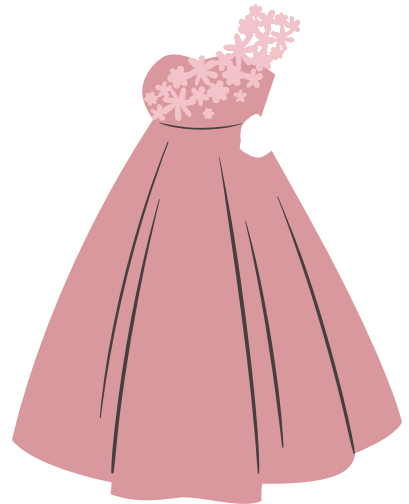
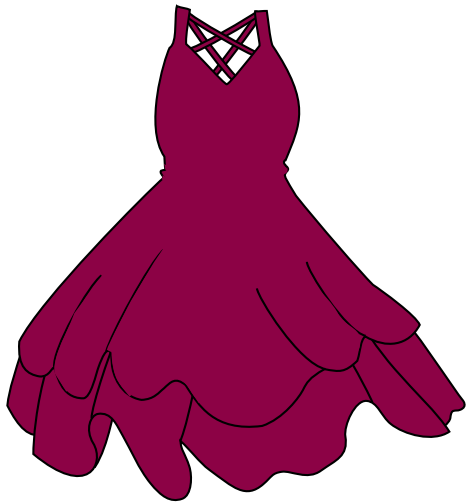

to honour those lost.**

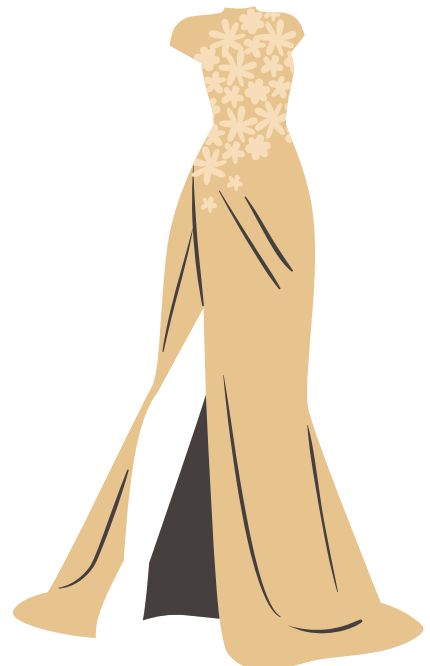




## Gowns for Grad

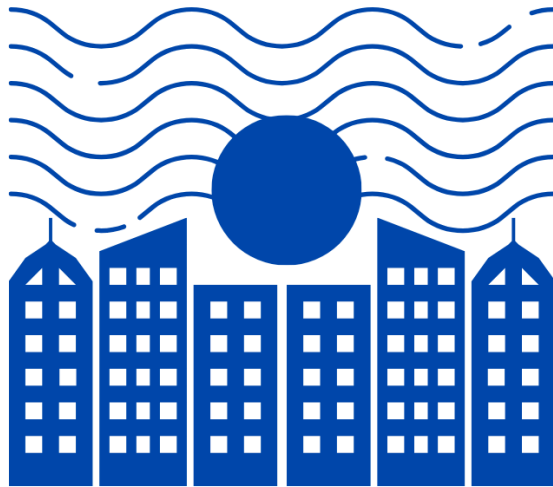
