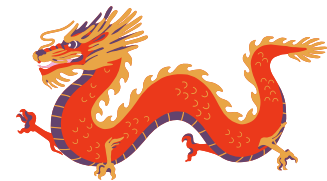

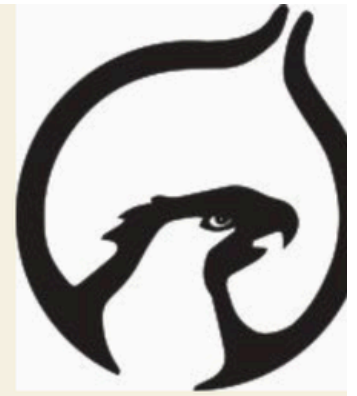
AGRICULTURE IN THE CLASSROOM FARM FIELD TRIP

ON SEPTEMBER 27TH HORTICULTURE CLASSES WENT ON AN ACTIVITY FILLED FIELD TRIP TO THE BRUCE CAMPBELL FARM AND FOOD DISCOVERY CENTER. THE FARM AND FOOD DISCOVERY CENTRE HELPS STUDENTS UNDERSTAND WHERE THEIR FOOD COMES FROM AND THE IMPORTANCE OF AGRICULTURE IN EVERYONE'S LIVES.
