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## **Shaughnessy Park Walking School Bus Information**

Shaughnessy Park School is pleased to offer our **Walking School Bus** for the 2021/2022 school year. Families who wish to participate will need to fill out the attached registration form and then wait to hear back regarding confirmation of start date. Please keep this page at home for your information.

The Walking School Bus (WSB) will operate daily EXCEPT on non-instructional days or when it is below -27 with the wind chill. The Winnipeg School Division uses temperature information from the forks. Please make sure to click on the hourly forecast as this is the temperature we go by. (<a href="www.winnipegsd.ca">www.winnipegsd.ca</a>) We will post weather closures on our Facebook page: the walking school bus for Shaughnessy school.

Our COVID safety protocols require all students and monitors to wear masks to and from school. While walking, we ask that siblings walk together and distance themselves from students who are not in their families. Families are asked to continue using the COVID symptom checker and keep all children home if any child/person in the home are showing symptoms of illness.

Shaughnessy Park Monitors will arrive to pick up your child/ren each day at or just after 8:30 am. Students will be dropped off at home by the Monitors between 3:30-4 pm. If there is no one home when we walk your child/ren home and we are unable to get ahold of you via phone/emergency contact, we will bring your child back to the school where they will wait with supervision until you arrive to pick them up. Please make every effort to let us know if you are running late so that your child/ren are not worried.

All questions, concerns or comments can be directed to Katherine Isfeld or our school administrators. We know that this program is greatly valued in our community by our families, our staff, and our students for:

- Increasing adult supervision before and after school which improves overall sense of safety
- Promoting physical fitness
- Supporting regular attendance
- Supporting community members with young children and caregiver duties at home We like to keep an open line of communication and are constantly reviewing and improving this program. Please do not hesitate to share feedback as our goal is to work together as a team!
