Administrators' Message

Hello and welcome back to École Stanley Knowles School! The first few days have gone smoothly for our students as we get back into routines in classrooms. There is a focus on getting to know each other and establishing classroom guidelines. Please reach out to your child's teacher if you have any questions or concerns.

I'd like to welcome Madame Hinther-Janus to our administration team at ÉSKS. Our new Vice Principal taught at Stanley Knowles many years ago, and is familiar with our school community. We are excited to have her back!

Our patrols and crossing guards are out on the street each day to ensure that our students have help in crossing our busy streets. Thank you for your continued support in following their direction. Please be mindful of our students if you are dropping off or picking up your children. Remember that our bus loop is not available for pick up and drop off between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm. The staff parking lot and condo parking lot across from the front of the school are also not available for parents.

This coming week, the teachers and staff at Ecole Stanley Knowles School will spend time teaching students about common expectations throughout the building. Our school uses a system for encouraging positive behaviours in the classroom and common areas called PBIS (Positive Behaviour—Interventions and Strategies). Our strategy has four pillars:

- * I am respectful
- * I am responsible
- * I am a learner
- * I am safe

We held two assemblies on the first day of school to welcome back our elementary and junior high students. At the assemblies, students were reminded that belonging and engagement are critically important to us. Every Student has a place at École Stanley Knowles School.

One of our goals every year is to build strong relationships with our students. We want each of our students to have a sense of belonging. As we look to nurture student engagement, one of our attendance strategies will be reaching out to families after a student has been away for a period of several days. We'd like to check in to see how the child is doing and remind them that we look forward to having them back. We thank our parents for ensuring that children who are sick are kept at home and ask that you continue to call our "Safe Arrival" number to let us know that your child will be away. This additional step, being done after the third day a child has been away, is meant to remind students that they are an important part of their classroom life.

By way of reminder, our school day begins with the 8:50 am morning bell. Our lunch hour is between 11:45 am and 12:40 pm. All students that are not in the Lunch Program are asked to be off of school property until 12:40 pm as there is no outdoor supervision. The day ends for all students at 3:30 pm.

Your child's teacher is always your first point of contact. If ever you have a questions or a concern, please reach out to them at the school @ 204 -694-0483 or by email. All teachers have created outlines of their year (what your child will be learning, classroom procedures, etc.) that will go home to families over the coming days.

We are partners in your child's education. We are excited for the year ahead and look forward to our ongoing connection and collaboration. École Stanley Knowles school uses an automated Call Back system called *SafeArrival*.

Here's a summary of how it works:

- Parents/guardians should notify the SafeArrival system of their child's absence in one of three ways:
 - By calling an automated interactive telephone system via a toll free number *1-855-278-4513*
 - * Via website *https://go.schoolmessenger.ca*
 - Or by using the *SafeArrival* app on your iOS or Android device
- After classroom attendance is taken at 9:00 am, and again at 12:45 pm, the SafeArrival system will begin contacting the parents/ guardians (by automated telephone call and/or email) of any student who is marked absent who has not already been reported absent by their parents/guardians.
- If the SafeArrival system is unable to reach parents/guardians or designated contacts after 20 minutes, the school office staff will follow up with a phone call.
- The SafeArrival system uses the contact information of parents/ guardians that has been provided to the school. If you have changed your telephone number or email address recently, or are not receiving notification calls, please follow up with the school office to ensure that we have the most current information on file.

If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the school.

Safety Reminders

Patrols and Adult Crossing Guard

Adult Crossing Guards and/or student Patrols are on duty at the following times:

Morning: 8:45 am – 9:00 am 11:45 am – 12:00 noon **Afternoon:** 12:30 pm – 12:45 pm 3:30 pm – 3:45 pm

It is extremely important that children who cross busy streets to get to school do so at specified corners where the adult crossing guards and/or patrols are on duty.

In order to protect the safety and welfare of the children, we emphasize the following:

- Please arrange for your children to arrive at school during the times that there are patrols/crossing guards and teachers/EAs on duty.
- ✓ We ask that parents/guardians who walk and pick up their children from school, use the crosswalks at the intersections, and not cross where there are no crosswalks. Modelling safe crossing will teach the children pedestrian safety.



Traffic and Parking

Traffic around École Stanley Knowles School is extremely heavy especially before and after school. Please slow down and be extra cautious and encourage your children to walk to and from school whenever possible.

If you must drop off or pick your children up from school, please drop them off 2 blocks away from school to avoid the traffic congestion and to ensure their safe arrival to school.

Please remember that the bus loop in front of the school, as well as the staff parking lot, should <u>NOT</u> be used to drop off or pick up students at any time.

Even if you are only going to stop for a minute, you may be preventing a school bus from safely entering or leaving the bus loop or you may be preventing a staff member from parking their vehicle and getting to work on time.

Any vehicles that are parked in the bus loop or the staff parking lot (even for minute) are subject to be ticketed and towed at the owner's expense.

We also ask that you be respectful to the tenants who live at the Tyndall Green Apartments on the corner of Kinver and King Edward and do not use their parking lot to drop off or pick up your children, as this interferes with the Tenants ability to enter or exit their lot.
