In February we celebrate reading! Although technology has advanced and there are many different formats and ways to read, sitting down, with a good book will never change! One of the best ways you can help your child at school, and in life, is to read to them every day when they are young. As your children get older, take the time to find out what they are reading. 
The Grade 7 students have been learning ukulele chords and strumming patterns and are currently working to play along to a variety of songs.


