EXPECTATIONS

- · Everyone will be at school every day, on time and prepared to work
- · Any late students will check in at the front door of the school
- Everyone will walk in the school in a quiet and safe manner
- · Everyone will show respect by speaking, writing and acting politely
- Students will keep their hands and feet to themselves
- · Students will remain in school or on the school grounds during the school day
- · Everyone will respect school and personal property
- Everyone at Strathcona School will respect and cooperate with others
- · Students will listen to all adults in the building
- Students will report home immediately after school

THE PLAYGROUND

While children engage in play and have fun and exercise they will be responsible for following the Strathcona School expectations listed on the previous page.

We are asking that the playground only be used for classroom cohorts during school hours. Please have students find their classroom lines immediately upon arrival to the school in the morning and afternoon.

STUDENT DROP-OFF AND PICK UP

Winnipeg School Division (WSD) believes every child and adult has the right to feel safe in our schools, every day. Our goal at Strathcona Elementary School is to have efficient and safe procedures that all parents follow when dropping off or picking up their children. This procedure allows school administration and staff to ensure that adults entering our school understand their responsibilities and that as a school community we all work together to create a safe and positive learning environment for our students.

- All students are asked to meet their teacher outside in the playground and courtyard areas of the school. The teacher will be waiting for your child at the classroom line outside in the morning (8:50am) and afternoon (12:55pm).
- Families are asked to pick up their children at the same designated area at the end of the morning (12:00 pm) and afternoon (3:30 pm).
- Students are asked not to arrive earlier than designated entry times.
- All Nursery and Kindergarten students must be escorted to the designated meeting place on the Alfred Street side of the school by their parent or caregiver every morning and must be picked up from the small park on Alfred Street, or alternatively a staff member will be present to bring the caregiver to the classroom at dismissal time. Adults picking up a child must be on the pick up list. In cases where an emergency pick up by another adult is inevitable, the guardian will inform the school office of the alternate. Staff will ask for identification of the designate.
- Those parents with children in grades 4-6 should wait for their teacher to escort the children out the court yard doors. Children are to leave the playground areas promptly upon dismissal.
- Any student that is not picked up by final dismissal will be brought to the office.

BEHAVIOUR EXPECTATIONS/PBIS

- Respectful
- Responsible
- Safe

Students will enter the building quietly, go to their rooms and follow the established classroom procedure. The students will store footwear, hang up coats, report to their desks, etc. The adult on duty will decide when the students should enter and appoint students to hold the doors. **Teachers should be on hand to supervise promptly at all entry times.**

Some general expectations for the students are that they will:

- Speak in a polite tone of voice to adults and others.
- Listen to adults and to classmates when they are speaking.
- Tell the truth and accept responsibility.
- Treat guest teachers and school visitors with respect.
- Act as ambassadors for the school when on patrol, field trips and other activities out of the building.
- o Be respectful to the adults when corrected about behaviour.
- Complete their assigned work.
- o Be accepting of other students on the playground.
- Know that Violence and bullying will not be tolerated.

In order to do this we must all give students the same message. At Strathcona School positive behaviour is an expectation. We focus on positive behavior intervention supports (PBIS) and Restorative Practices (RP) – providing safe environments to repair harm, restore and build relationships.

Our overall objective is to develop appropriate behaviour for school. The reason for this behaviour is so that everyone can learn and everyone can be safe and happy. The way that we will make this works is to insist that students act properly and also through supervision. We need to tell students very clearly how we want them to behave and make sure that they do, particularly at the beginning of the school year.
