PRINCIPAL AND VICE-PRINCIPAL MESSAGE

Welcome back everyone! We hope you had a great summer. École Waterford Springs School staff are excited to work with all of our returning students as well as getting to know our many new students. Please take the time to read the information in this newsletter and the attached WSD Code of Conduct which guides our school staff, students and family members.

A lot of communication will happen with parents through email or through Seesaw or Google Classroom with teachers. Please make sure that the office has your updated contact information, including email address and phone number throughout the year.

We welcome Mrs. Maria Manzano who will be our Acting Vice-Principal until the end of December as Ms. Amanda Manness has been asked to be Acting Principal at a different school for the first four months.

Construction:

We are excited about the addition that is being built onto our school that will give us an additional 10 classrooms. The construction is slated to hopefully be done by December 2023. Some classrooms will be housed in other rooms in the school until the addition is complete and we can move the students and teachers into their brand new classrooms. We will have two rooms in the library, one in the MPR and one in the Music room. Music programming will continue but in students' classrooms.

Due to the construction at our school, parking on Jefferson Avenue will continue as 2 hour parking from 7am to 5:30pm September to December.

Student Drop Off & Pick Up Process:

Due to limited parking space, we are strongly encouraging all families to walk or bike to and from school as much as possible.

We have a "Drop and Go" loop between 8:30am and 8:55am. The loop closest to the front entrance of the school will only be used to drop children off. All grade 1-8 students will go to the school field (south side) when they arrive in the morning. School staff will assist in directing students to the field and there will also be staff supervising in the field.

- There will be no supervision before 8:30 am. Students will enter the school at 8:45 am.
- Limited parking is still available in the inside loop where spots are marked for parking.
- Please do not stop at the entrance to the parking lot as that blocks cars from entering and puts the patrols in danger.
- No parking in the daycare parking at anytime unless you have a child in daycare.
- Nursery and Kindergarten students will use the north doors near their classrooms for arrival and dismissal times.

We are looking forward to a great year with you and your children.



Each year we are required to practice elements of our school safety plan.

10 fire drills are practiced, one per month. We also practice 3 lockdown drills, and 3 hold and secure drills, one each in the fall, winter and spring.

A lockdown would be used to secure the interior of the school if a potentially dangerous intruder enters the building.

A hold and secure would be used in case something was happening outside of the school, either on school grounds or in the nearby community. All doors would be locked so that no one would come into the building. Regular routines would continue in the school.



Peanut, Nut & Scent Free

At École Waterford Springs School we are a Peanut and Nut free school. There are students and staff here who have severe allergies. When making lunches for your children please take this into consideration.

Cell Phones

Many students bring cell phones to school. These can be a safety measure for children who walk to and from school on a daily basis. Cell phones are to be turned off during the school hours, including lunch time. If there is an urgency in contacting your child, please call the school office and we will work with you to get the message to your child.

Medical Concerns

Please alert the office if your child has any allergies, asthma or any other medical concerns.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONTINUED.

Due to limited parking space, we are strongly encouraging all families to walk to and from school as much as possible.

We have a "Drop and Go" loop between 8:30am and 8:55am.

The loop closest to the front entrance of the school will only be used to drop off children.

Parents are not to park and get out of their cars in this loop as it blocks other cars from dropping off their children.

The visitor parking loop is for those parents who need to get out of the car.

Parents are also not to stop at the entrance to the school property as it blocks traffic on Jefferson Avenue and is dangerous for everyone. Unless dropping off a child at the preschool daycare, no parking in their parking lot is permitted.

Grade 1-8 students will go to the school field (south side) when they arrive in the morning. School staff will assist in directing students to the field and there will also be staff supervising in the field. There will be no supervision before 8:30 am. Students will enter the school at 8:45 am.

Nursery and Kindergarten students will use the north doors near their classrooms for arrival and dismissal times (if any N/K are late, or arrive after 9:00AM, please come to the front doors.)

REPORTING YOUR CHILD'S ABSENCE: SAFE ARRIVAL

SafeArrival is a student absence reporting system that:

- increases student safety by allowing staff to respond to unexplained absences more efficiently

If you report an absence in advance or before the morning bell time you will not receive a call. We will be using the Safe Arrival automated notification system to contact parents/guardians if a child is absent and the absence was not reported in advance. Safe Arrival attempts to contact parents/guardians at multiple contact numbers until the designated contact(s) is/are reached.

What is a Split Classroom?

Split Classes: A split class, for example, Grade 5/6, is created when there are either many students or not enough students registered for those grade levels. Split classes help to balance the number of students in each grade. The teacher still teaches grade 5 students their curriculum and grade 6 students their curriculum. They are not set up as advanced classes and students do not skip the next grade level the following year. Grade 5 students in a split class will go to grade 6 the next school year, and so on. We hope this helps to clarify any confusion as split classes are common in most schools.

Battery Recycling at École Waterford Springs School

Hello EWSS families.

Don't throw out your batteries—recycle them! Improper battery disposal can hurt wildlife and the environment, and put your family at risk too.



Recycling your batteries helps protect your community and wildlife from materials that may harm the environmen they end up in landfills. Also, metals reclaimed from recycled batteries can be used to make new products which helps in the development of a circular economy for a more sustainable future. (adapted from call2recycle program)

To help our community recycle their used household batteries, EWSS will collect your used batteries.

Follow these simple instructions for battery recycling:

1. Gather

Collect any used household batteries* in your house, office, garage, drawers and in old electronics such as toys, remote controls, game consoles, cordless power tools and more.

2. Tape

For safe handling, we recommend you tape the ends of your used batteries before you send them to prevent batteries from touching and possibly causing a spark.

3. Send

Send your used batteries to school with your child. Your child can drop them off in the containers located at the designated spots in the school (1st floor in the office or 2nd floor room 2W02)
*Please no car batteries or batteries weighing over 5 kg each.

Then what?

The Teachers in charge will safely transport the batteries to a recycling depot.

Thank you for your support in helping us to make our planet sustainable.





MESSAGE FROM THE PARENT COUNCIL


