Our story

The name Kaakiyow li moond likol is from the Michif language, meaning “All peoples’ school.” Our learning centre was created 2007 as response to the community members’ voices stating the need for a place to learn, to earn a high school diploma, and to continue moving toward their dreams.

What we do

Kaakiyow li moond likol is an adult learning centre that offers approved Manitoba curriculum courses to adults so that they can achieve their high school diploma. We take pride in offering:

- **FREE** adult focused courses
- **SMALL** class sizes
- **HELPFUL** staff and tutors

Who may attend

Kaakiyow li moond likol is open to all people aged 19 or older. We may ask you to do a math and English assessment so that we can help you choose the courses that will best suit your skill level.



Courses offered

We offer courses from Grade 10-12.

Math and English courses are offered throughout the school year.

Optional courses vary by trimester.

Although our courses are divided into three trimesters, we also offer continuous enrolment courses.

- Classes run Monday to Friday.
- Wednesdays are one on one resource time.
- We follow the regular school year and holidays.
- Eight high school credits are required to graduate.
- Bring a transcript, some of your previous credits may be used toward graduation.
