#### **School Run Lunch Program**

The lunch program, which is currently run by parent council, will be taken over by the school in January. For those of you who have paid for January and/or other months beyond, you will receive a reimbursement.

Thank you to parent council, Michelle, and all the parents and staff that worked the lunch program. Your efforts did not go unnoticed, and our students benefited from your dedication.

Starting January, the school will run lunch program. We will continue to split the kids into two groups (primary and intermediate). The primary group (rooms 1,2, and 3) will eat their lunches the first half hour while the intermediate group (rooms 8,10, 9, and 13) will have their recess first. At 12:30 we will switch, and the primary group will have recess and the intermediate group will have their lunches.

The lunch program rules will remain the same when the school takes over the program in January. No heat ups and due to life threating allergies the food restrictions will remain the same. **No nuts/peanuts, seafood/fish or sesame seeds or oils.** (Example of this is Hummus)

We will have two EAs with each group. Two EAs will be outside with their group of students while the other two EAs will circulate through the classrooms who are eating. I will be reaching out to Isaac Brock School to see if we can have a few Grade 9 students come out and help pad the supervision.

Grade 9 students can use the supervision as volunteer hours which work towards a high school credit.
